

What to Expect: IV Sedation Pre-Op

Many patients choose to be sedated for their treatment for a variety of reasons. Regardless of your reasons, it is important to know the benefits and risks of all types of procedures. If you would like to review the consents and information available regarding your upcoming treatment prior to your appointment, please let any of our dental team members know and we'll be happy to provide that to you. Here are some things to remember:

- It is very important not to eat or drink within 6 hours prior to your appointment.
- Many patients are prescribed antibiotics for before and pain medication for after treatment. It's a good idea to have any necessary prescriptions filled and picked up prior to your appointment.
- What you wear is important. Comfortable clothes are encouraged but, please, no flip-flops.
- Patients are required to have a driver bring you, stay during treatment, and take you home. Minors will also need a legal guardian to accompany them.
- Due to the scheduling requirements of this type of treatment, a 72-hour notice to reschedule or cancel is appreciated.
